

FINAL PROJECT PART 6 - PRESENTATION

Deliver a 3 to 5 minute presentation based on your research.

This is your chance to be creative about the way you present the topic to your peers. The media equipment normally present in the classroom will be available to you. You are welcome to discuss the format of your presentation with your instructor. Students often opt for a slide show or an interactive performance, but there are many other valid formats to choose from. Ideally, your presentation will not be a mere reading of your research paper, but an engaging and fun way to share what you have learned about the topic.

It is a good idea to practice your presentation several times while timing yourself, so that you can be confident and within the allotted time limit during the final delivery.

Because the presentation plays the role usually taken by the final exam, the attendance is mandatory; failing to attend or participate during the final project presentation may result in a failing grade for the class, in accordance with our syllabus policy.
